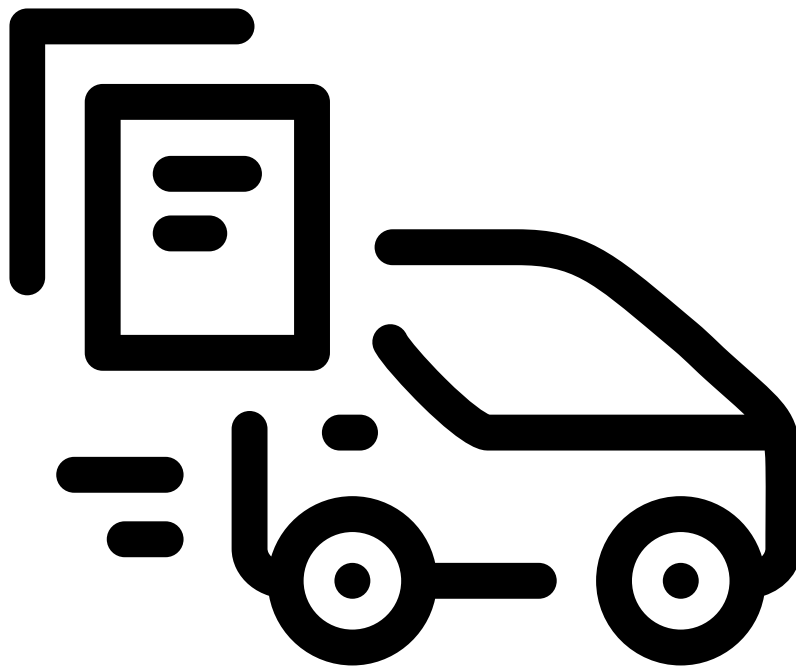

### 1 Introduction

This document describe the steps to remove the existing certificate and install the new one.

The process must be completed before 31<sup>th</sup> August 2023, as the current certificate expires on this date.

This process should be executed in all servers that have Navision Service or BusinessCentral Services.

In versions bellow Navision 2016 the certificate could also be installed in each user PC. If its you case, alter install the certificate in all User's PCs.

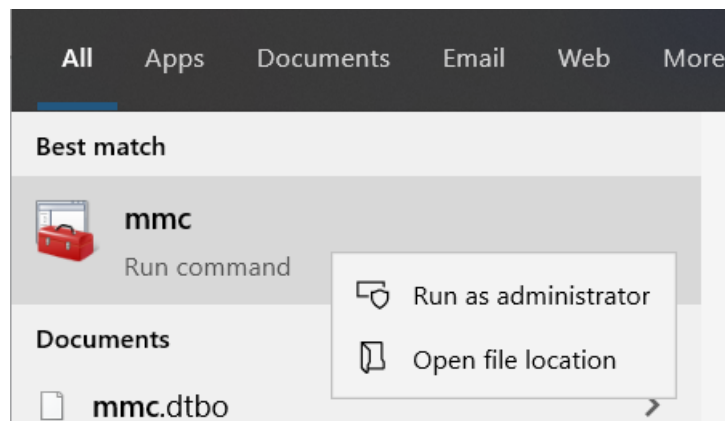

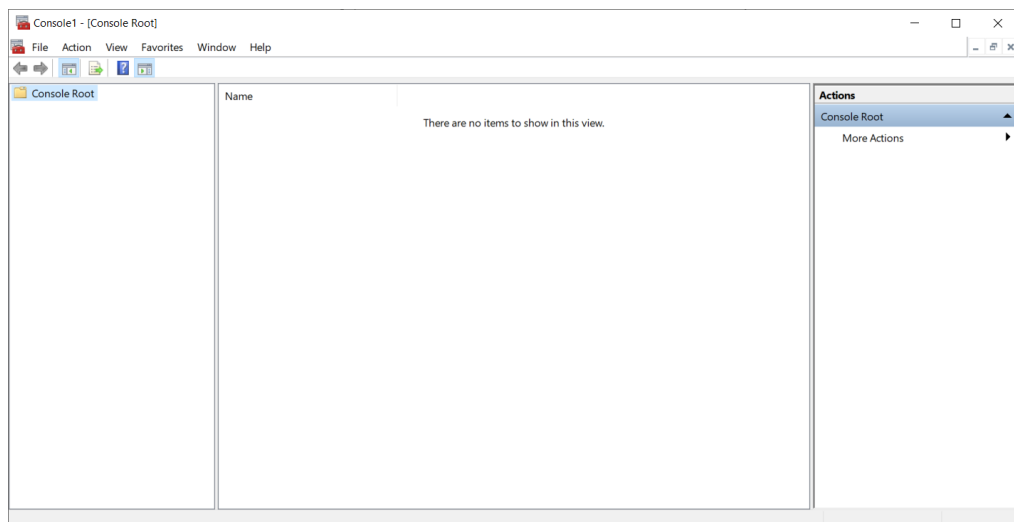

The Console Root window will open.



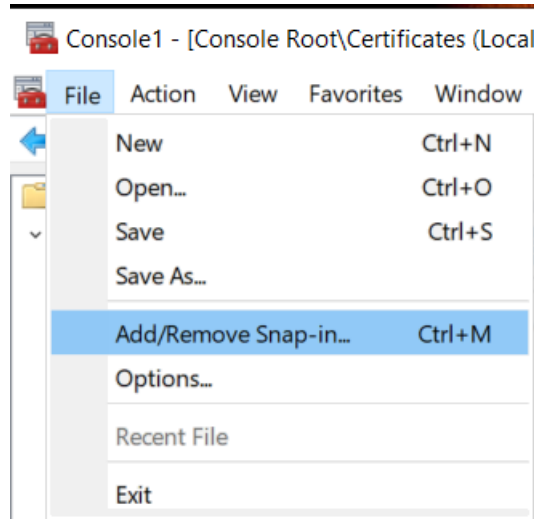

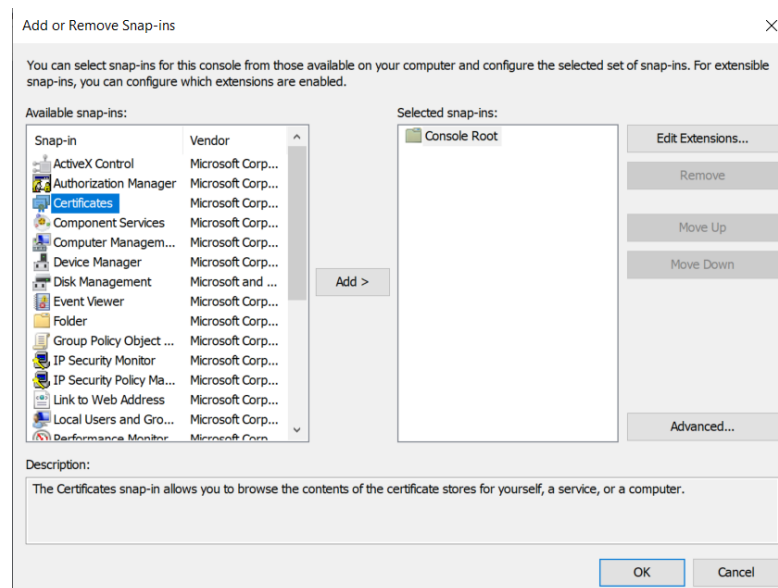

Select the snap-in "Certificates" and click the button "Add >"



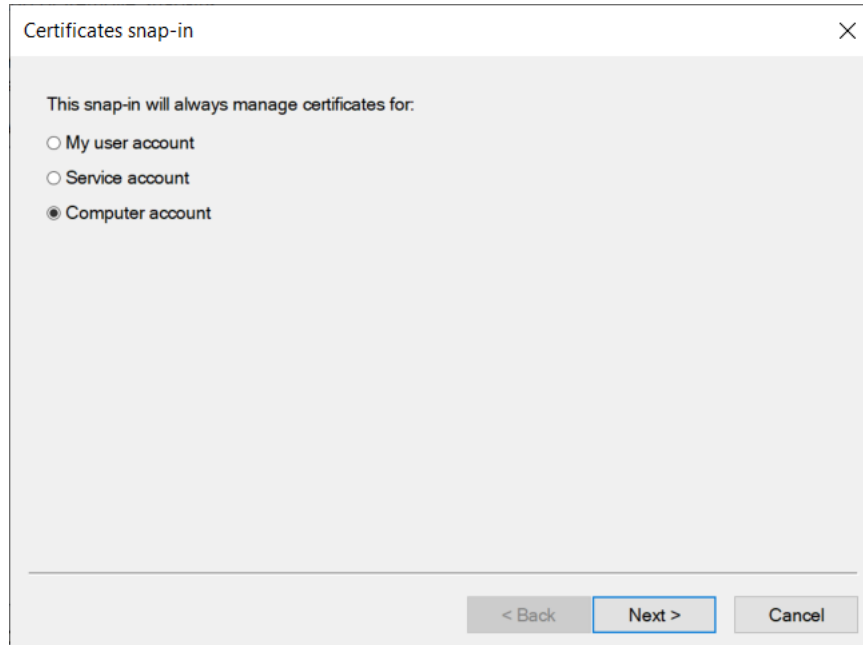

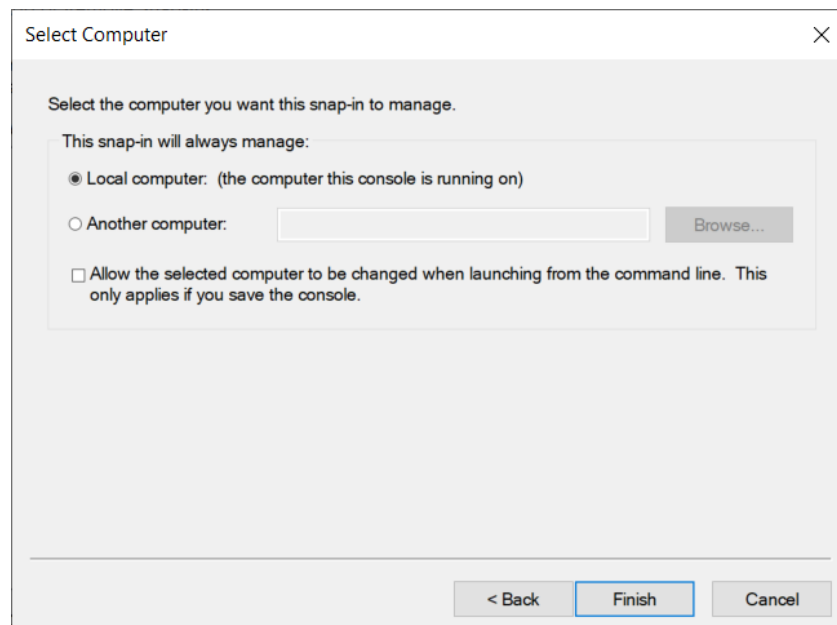

Then, select "OK".

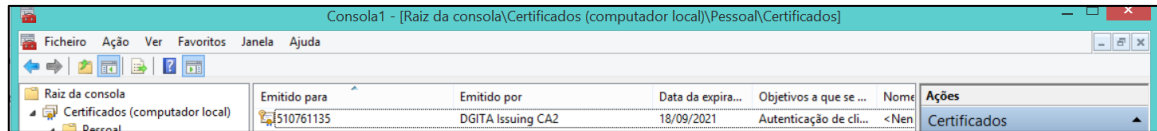

### 5 Changing “Thusted Root Certification Authorities”

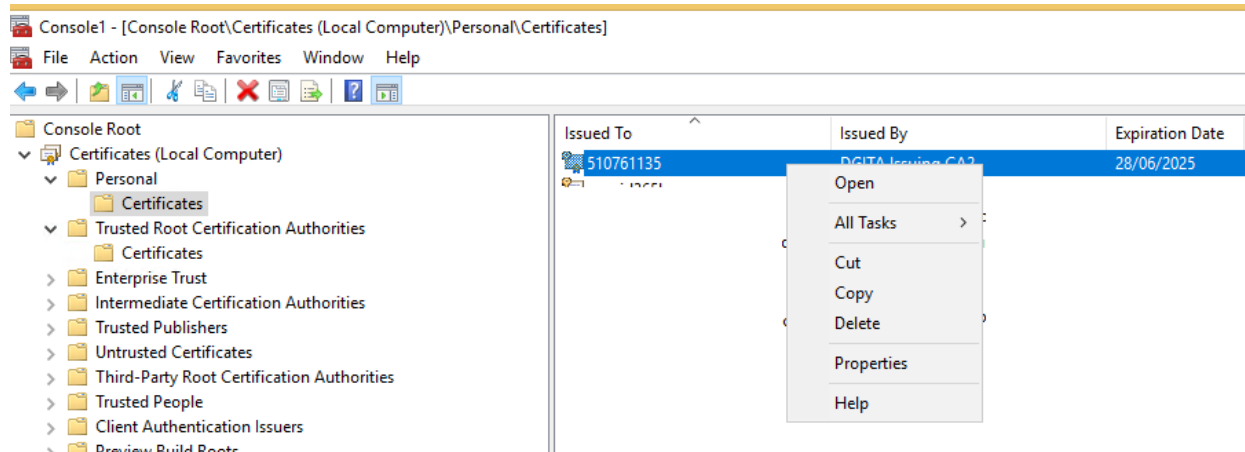
Some installations may have the certificate in the “Thusted Root Certification Authorities”. If the certificate isn't there, you can stop because you don't need to do anything.

In this image the certificate is also installed and need to be updated.

Go to personal folder and copy the certificate



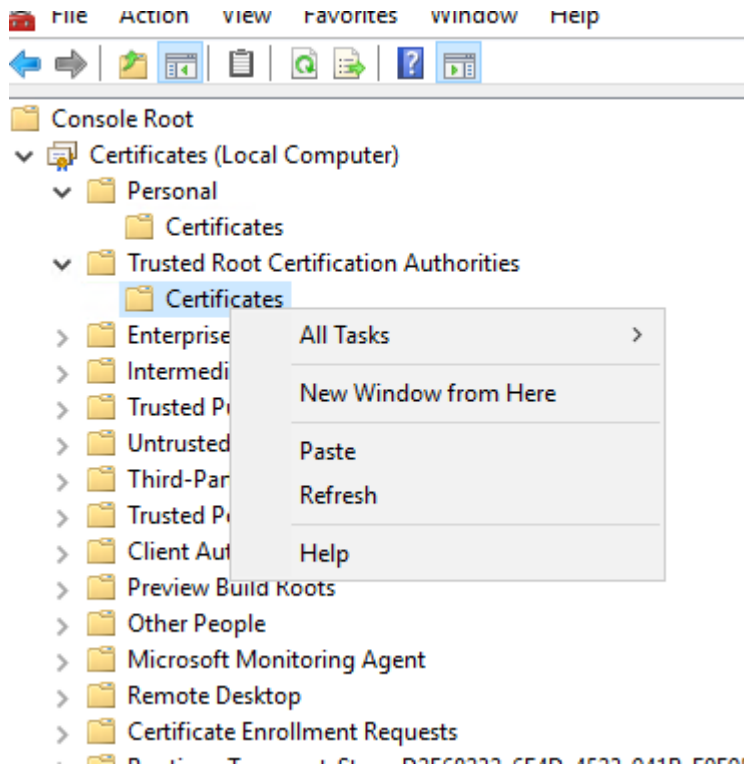
Select the “Certificates” folder inside “Thusted Root Certification Authorities” and paste.
